FLORIDA'S COUNCIL 5 COMPROMISING A LIEN ASSOCIATED WITH CODE 6 COMPLIANCE ACTIONS NOH-9-2387 AND NOH-11-2102 7 FOR 10726 VERSAILLES BLVD, PURSUANT TO SECTION 8 2-199 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING 9 AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 10 11 12 WHEREAS, Section 2-199 of the Wellington Code of Ordinances provides a 13 lien arising from a fine imposed pursuant to this article runs in favor of the Village 14 Council, and the Village Council may execute a satisfaction or release of lien entered 15 pursuant to this article; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the Wellington Special Magistrate entered an Order Imposing Penalty/Lien on October 15, 2009, and September 15, 2011, for violations of 18 19 Wellington's Codes and Ordinances at the property located at 10726 Versailles 20 Blvd; and 21 22 WHEREAS, the code compliance liens were filed with the Palm Beach County 23 Clerk and Comptroller Office; and 24 25 WHEREAS, the violations associated with the code compliance action were 26 corrected; and 27 28 WHEREAS, Property owner, Ronald Okon, submitted a reduction application 29 seeking a reduction of the liens associated with NOH-9-2387 and NOH-11-2102 code compliance actions. 30 31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S 32 33 **COUNCIL THAT:** 34 35 **SECTION 1.** The above recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified as being true 36 and correct. 37 **SECTION 2.** This Agreement to Compromise the Lien is made and entered 38 39 between the Village of Wellington Council and Ronald Okon (collectively the 40 "Parties"). 41 42 **SECTION 3.** Lien is reduced to the sum of \$3,500.00, (the "Settlement Sum"). The Settlement Sum is now due to Wellington, provided that payment is received by 43
