SECTION 1: Section 2.292(b) shall be amended as follows:

requirements for being a board member. All board and committee members shall serve at the pleasure of the Wellington Council. Board and committee members appointed by individual Council members may be removed without cause by the Council member who appointed the board or committee member, unless otherwise provided by the Charter or Florida Statutes. No vote by the Wellington Council shall be required for such removal. At large board and committee

members may be removed by a majority vote of the Council, unless otherwise provided by the Charter or Florida Statutes. Any member so removed shall have

Removal for reasons other than absenteeism and failure to maintain the

the right to request a hearing before the Wellington Council.

SECTION 2. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance conflict with any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of any prior
