- > (80) new narcotic cases
- > (81) suspects arrested







Traffic Issues


Performance Goal: Achieve a crash rate of 2.2 or less crashes per 100 Village Residents








Calls for Service By Location



Wellington Case Numbers by Type





Wellington Arrests by Type




Illegal Drug Offense Arrests
