17NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE18VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: Chapter 3 SPECIAL ASSESSMENT of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Wellington is hereby amended by creating a new Section 3-9 which shall read as follows:

24 SECTION 3-9. Prepayment of Special Assessments.

Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 170.09, Florida Statutes,
 Section 3-7(b) of this Chapter or any other provision of law pertaining to
 the prepayment of special assessments, the Village Council may, in its
 discretion, by enabling resolution(s), provide for restrictions or limitations
 on, including a prohibition of, the prepayment of special assessments
 levied by the Village.

32 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this 33 Ordinance conflict with any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of any prior 34 Wellington Ordinance, Resolution, or Municipal Code provision; then in that event 35 the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.

36 <u>SECTION 3:</u> Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this 37 Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision 38 shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole as a whole or any portion or part 39 thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid. 40

- 41 <u>SECTION 4:</u> This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption
 42 of the Wellington Council following second reading.
