10	WHEREAS the Wallington Floride Council purpuent to the outherity in Chapters
11 12	WHEREAS, the Wellington, Florida Council, pursuant to the authority in Chapters 163 and 166, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider changes to its
12 13	land development regulations; and

15	WHEREAS, the purpose and intent of the off-street parking and loading
16	standards in the Wellington Land Development Regulations is to ensure that parking
17	and loading facilities are provided based upon the density and intensity of residential
18	and non-residential uses; and

20	WHEREAS, the proposed amendments to Article 7, Chapter 2 are designed to
21	simplify the "parking code," to support the transition of uses within the non-residential
22	developments, to assist with their viability and to simplify the application of the code for
23	future development; and
24 25	WHEREAS, On April 8, 2015, the Equestrian Preserve Committee has reviewed
26	the proposed Ordinance with respect to changes affecting the Equestrian Overlay
27	Zoning District and recommended approval with changes to the Planning, Zoning and
28	Adjustment Board; and

30	WHEREAS, the Planning, Zoning and Adjustment Board, acting as The Land
31	Development Regulation Board, after notice and public hearing on August 5, 2015, has
32	reviewed the proposed Ordinance and determined that the proposed amendment is
33	consistent with Wellington's Comprehensive Plan and recommended approval to the
34 25	Village Council; and
35 36	WHEREAS, the Council has taken the recommendations from the Local
30 37	Planning Agency, Wellington staff and the comments from the public into consideration
38	when considering the amendments to the Land Development Regulations that are the
39	subject of this Ordinance.

41	NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF WELLINGTON,
42	FLORIDA THAT:

44	SECTION 1. Article 7. Site Development Standards, Chapter 2. Off-street
45	Parking and Loading of Wellington's Land Development Regulations is hereby modified,

as presented in Exhibit 1; [text formatted with <u>underline</u> is to be added; text formatted
 with strike-through is to be deleted].

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this
 Ordinance conflict with any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of any prior Wellington
 Ordinance, Resolution, or Municipal Code provision; then in that event the provisions of
 this Ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.

- SECTION 3. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phase of this
 Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision
 shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole as a whole or any portion or part
 thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
