23	WHEREAS, Section 166.031, Florida Statutes, provides that the governing body					
24 25	of a municipality may, by ordinance, submit to the electors of the municipality a					
25 26	proposed amendment to the municipality's charter; and					
27	WHEREAS, the original charter makes no reference to the Equestrian Preserve					
28	Area; and

30 31	WHEREAS, the proposed amendment would formally recognize the importance of Wellington's equestrian community, preserve and protect the equestrian community					
32	as outlined in the Village's Comprehensive Plan; and

34	WHEREAS, Wellington's Council deems it necessary and advisable for the					
35	voters of Wellington to consider amending the charter of the Village of Wellington to					
36 37	formally recognize the importance of Wellington's equestrian community, preserve and protect the equestrian community as outlined in the Village's Comprehensive Plan, and					
38	to require three affirmative votes to add parcels to the Equestrian Preserve Area and					
39	not less than four affirmative votes to remove parcels from the Equestrian Preserve					
40	Area; and

SECTION 1: A new Section 4, "Equestrian Preserve Area" is hereby proposed to be added as follows:

Section 4. Equestrian Preserve Area.

*

Expanding on the legislative intent at incorporation that the unique characteristics of individual communities be preserved and recognizing the importance of Wellington's equestrian community to the vitality of Wellington, it shall be a village priority to preserve and protect the equestrian community as outlined in the village's comprehensive plan. Accordingly, the village may increase the boundaries of the Equestrian Preserve Area by majority vote, but may not contract the boundaries except by affirmative vote of not less than four members of council.

SECTION 2. The charter amendment proposed by this ordinance shall be

17 18	submitted to the electors of the Village of Wellington at the election to be held on March 15, 2016 and shall be deemed adopted upon the favorable vote of a majority of the

35	SECTION 3. In the event of adoption by the electorate as provided herein,			
36 37	Wellington's Clerk shall forthwith incorporate the amendment into Wellington's charter by preparing a true copy of new section 4 as amended, and shall file the revised section			
38	with the Florida Department of State, at which time the revised section shall take effect.

40	SECTION 4. Wellington's Clerk shall cause this ordinance to be published once			
41	a week for four consecutive weeks immediately prior to the election on March 15, 2016.

43	SECTION 5. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this			
44	Ordinance conflict with any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of any prior Wellington			
45	Ordinance, Resolution, or Municipal Code provision; then in that event the provisions of			
46	this Ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.			

1	SECTION 6: Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this						
2	Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision						
3	shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole as a whole or any portion or part						
4 5	thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.						
6	SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall becon	ne effective imm	ediately upon adoption				
7 8	of the Wellington Council following second reading.
