

**AN ORDINANCE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL AMENDING THE DATE OF THE QUALIFYING PERIOD FOR THE 2018 MUNICIPAL ELECTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, section 100.3605 of the Florida Statutes permits municipal governments, by ordinance, to change the dates for qualifying and for election of members of the governing body of the municipality; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE  
VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA, THAT:**

(a) Qualifying Period for candidates will be from noon on December 5, 2017 to noon on December 19, 2017.

**SECTION 4:** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance conflict with any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of any prior Village Ordinance, Resolution, or municipal Code provision, then in that event the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 4:** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any portion or part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

**SECTION 5:** The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
