AS CONTAINED HEREIN: TO ESTABLISH SPECIFIC STANDARDS RELATED TO THE DEVELOPMENT REVIEW 8 **PROCEDURES FOR DEVELOPMENT APPLICATIONS:** 9 PROVIDING Α CONFLICTS **CLAUSE: PROVIDING** 10 SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 11 12 WHEREAS, the Village Council, Florida, as the governing body, pursuant to the 13 14 authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider changes to its Land Development Regulations (LDR); and 15 16 17 WHEREAS, upon incorporation in 1996, the Village elected to utilize the Palm Beach County (PBC) Unified Land Development Code (ULDC), as the LDR for the Village of 18 Wellington; and 19 20 WHEREAS, over the years minor amendments to the LDR have been codified to 21 address changed conditions or to modify the code to suit specific needs of the Village to 22 23 ensure the health, safety, welfare and overall quality of life; and 24 WHEREAS. Wellington believes that it is in the best interest of the community to make 25 26 additional modifications to the LDR to streamline the development review process, to establish a process that best serves the public, and to create an incentive for betterment of 27 future development and redevelopment; 28 29 WHEREAS, A Development Review Manual has been adopted by Resolution No. 30 R2017-40, in accordance with section 5.2.2(A) of the Land Development Regulations (Exhibit 31 32 A of this ordinance); and 33 WHEREAS, The Planning, Zoning and Adjustment Board, acting as the Local Planning 34 Agency, after notice and public hearing on August 9, 2017, has reviewed the proposed 35 Ordinance for consistency with Wellington's Comprehensive Plan and made a 36 recommendation for \_\_\_\_\_ with a \_\_\_\_ - \_\_\_ vote; and 37 38 39 WHEREAS, Village Council has taken the recommendations from the Local Planning Agency, Wellington staff and the comments from the public into consideration as part of the 40 review of the proposed amendment to the LDR that are the subject of this Ordinance. 41
