The hearing has been postponed and the new date is **Monday, October 16th**, **2017 at 6:30 P.M**. The purpose of this hearing is to determine if you or those in your employ have

committed a willful violation of the provisions of the Florida Building Code, specifically sections: 105.4.1, 105.4.1.3, 105.4.1.5, 105.5.3.

Please be advised that you have until **Monday, October 2nd, 2017** to <u>close</u> all of your expired permits in order to be relieved from attending this hearing.

According to Section 489.113, Florida Statutes and Section 113.4 of Florida Building Code as amended by Village of Wellington, the Construction Board of Adjustments and Appeals (CBAA) will convene as the Local Construction Regulation Board (LCRB).

As the LCRB the CBAA may deny, suspend, revoke, or limit your authority as a certified contractor to obtain a building permit or permits with specific conditions, if the LCRB finds through the public hearing process that you or those you employ committed fraud or a willful building code violation within the Village of Wellington.

The quasi-judicial proceeding in the above matter will only consider the evidence presented and heard at a Regular Meeting of the Wellington Construction Board of Adjustments and Appeals scheduled for **Monday October 16th**, **2017 at 6:30 P.M.**
