## ORDINANCE NO. 2018-01

2 AN ORDINANCE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL AMENDING 3 4 THE WELLINGTON LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS, MORE SPECIFICALLY, A ZONING TEXT AMENDMENT TO REPEAL AND 5 REPLACE ARTICLE 1, GENERAL PROVISIONS, AND ARTICLE 14, 6 ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS AND PENALTIES, IN THEIR ENTIRETY; 7 REPLACING THEM WITH ARTICLE 1 GENERAL PROVISIONS AS 8 CONTAINED HEREIN; TO ESTABLISH SPECIFIC STANDARDS RELATED 9 TO GENERAL PROVISIONS AND ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS AND 10 PENALTIES: PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE: PROVIDING A 11 SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 12

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14 **WHEREAS,** the Village Council, Florida, as the governing body, pursuant to the 15 authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, is authorized and 16 empowered to consider changes to its Land Development Regulations (LDR); and

18 **WHEREAS,** upon incorporation in 1996, the Village elected to utilize the Palm Beach 19 County (PBC) Unified Land Development Code (ULDC), as the LDR for the Village of 20 Wellington; and

## WHEREAS, over the years minor amendments to the LDR have been codified to address changed conditions or to modify the code to suit specific needs of the Village to ensure the health, safety, welfare and overall quality of life; and

WHEREAS, Wellington believes that it is in the best interest of the community to make additional modifications to the LDR to streamline the development review process, to establish a process that best serves the public, and to create an incentive for betterment of future development and redevelopment; and

WHEREAS, The Planning, Zoning and Adjustment Board, acting as the Local Planning Agency, after notice and public hearing on December 13, 2017, has reviewed the proposed Ordinance for consistency with Wellington's Comprehensive Plan and made a recommendation for \_\_\_\_\_\_ with a \_\_\_\_ - \_\_\_\_ vote; and

WHEREAS, Village Council has taken the recommendations from the Local Planning Agency, Wellington staff and the comments from the public into consideration as part of the review of the proposed amendment to the LDR that are the subject of this Ordinance.

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## 40 NOW THERFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF WELLINGTON, 41 FLORIDA THAT:

43 **SECTION 1.** Article 14 Enforcement Proceedings and Penalties and Article 1 General 44 Provisions, of the Wellington Land Development Regulations, are hereby repealed and 45 replaced in their entirety as Article 1, as specifically provided for in Exhibit A of the Ordinance. 46
