**RESOLUTION NO. R2018-14**

**A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL  
REVISING THE RULES OF PROCEDURES FOR ALL OFFICIAL  
MEETINGS OF COUNCIL TO EXPRESSLY APPLY THE  
PROCEDURES TO ALL BOARDS AND COMMITTEES,  
PROHIBIT REMOTE ATTENDANCE FOR QUASI-JUDICIAL  
HEARINGS, ADDRESS PUBLIC COMMENT FOR CONSENT  
ITEMS, INCLUDE AN ADDITIONAL TIME FOR PUBLIC  
FORUM, STREAMLINE PARLIAMENTARY RULES AND  
REORDER THE INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE;  
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Wellington's Council previously adopted Rules of Procedures for Council meetings through the passage of Resolution R2011-75; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council desires to amend the Rules of Procedure in an effort to provide more streamlined rules governing various Village meetings and to include (1) an express statement that the procedures apply to all boards and committees as well as council; (2) a provision prohibiting remote attendance at quasi-judicial hearings; (3) clarification concerning public comment for consent items; (4) inclusion of a public forum at both the beginning and end of the meeting; (5) streamlined parliamentary rules governing debates and motions; and (6) reordering of the invocation and Pledge of Allegiance.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WELLINGTON FLORIDA'S COUNCIL  
THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified as being true and correct.

**SECTION 2.** The Wellington Council hereby adopts this Resolution approving the revised Council Procedures attached hereto as Exhibit A.

**SECTION 3:** This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
