ADDENDUM NO. ONE

PURPOSE: The purpose of this Addendum/NOTICE is to make changes, additions, deletions, revisions, and clarifications to the (ITB) Invitation to Bid documents for the Big Blue Trace/Barberry Drive Turn Lane Addition and Culvert Replacement. Bidder shall review the Addendum/NOTICE work and requirements in detail and incorporate any effects the Addendum/NOTICE may have in their proposal price.

- 1. Attached to this addendum please find the following documents:
 - a. Revised Schedule of Values dated 3/14/17
 - b. Topographic Survey performed by Engenuity Group Inc (7 pages)
 - c. Revised plan sheets with clouded changes (8 pages)
- 2. Clarification: For clarification purposes, it will be the contractor's responsibility to retain the services of a specialty engineer, as needed, to design the temporary cofferdam or earthen dam system. Furthermore, it is also the contractor's responsibility to retain the services of a specialty engineer, as needed, to design any temporary retaining wall required for the excavation and removal of the existing culvert. The specialty engineer must be a licensed Professional Engineer registered in the State of Florida and must have experience in the design of cofferdams, earthen dam systems, and retaining walls. Notes pertaining to this requirement may be found on Sheet 30 of 36 in the bid plans prepared by Kimley-Horn.
- 3. Question: What is the estimate for this project?

Response: The engineer's estimate for this project is \$1,320,000.

- Question: Can we detour traffic on Barberry so we can close the road?
 Response: No detours or road closures will be permitted for this project.
- 5. Question: What is the anticipated start date?

Response: We anticipate construction to begin the first week in May. Please be advised from Notice to Proceed until June 4, 2018 and from August 3, 2018 to project completion, the contractor must have a minimum of (2) 12-ft travel lanes passable and pedestrian pathways (sidewalks) open for pedestrian traffic on both sides of roadway

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT: Bidder must acknowledge receipt of any and all Addenda in the space provided on the Bidder Submittal Form. Failure to do so may result in rejection of the Proposal. All requirements of the proposal documents remain unchanged except as cited herein.


