13	Agency (TPA), be a forum for cooperative decision making by officials of the				
14	governmental entities with voting membership on the TPA Governing Board; and				
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16	WHEREAS, the Village of Wellington is a governmental entity with voting				
17	membership on the TPA Governing Board; and				
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19	WHEREAS, the TPA Governing Board adopted Resolution 2017-08 to formally				
20	recognize the value of empowering all of its members to lead the selection of				
21	transportation projects and programs to best serve our local communities, to take steps				
22	to avoid undue influence by any member agencies, and to provide the TPA with maximum				
23 24	flexibility to provide transportation planning services to the public; and				
24 25	WHEREAS, certain activities such as advocacy and lobbying at the federal and				
26	state levels, hosting peer exchanges or special events, purchasing promotional materials,				
27	and providing non-federal monetary matching funds for TPA planning grants, are not				
28	permitted under the current funding sources; and

30	WHEREAS, not being able to participate in these activities results in a competitive				
31	disadvantage with other MPOs across the nation in advancing the priorities of the TPA				
32	Governing Board; and				
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34	WHEREAS, financial participation for all governmental entities with voting				
35	membership on the TPA Governing Board is equitable and will allow the TPA to engage				
36	in critical activities to advance TPA transportation priorities.
