Also, materials are not funded by the school district for this class. This means that we have to be very creative in offering support to our students. We will be paying teachers to instruct students during their planning periods and offering multiple kinds of tutorials: Estimated Cost: \$7,000.00 Supplemental curriculum materials: Estimated Cost: \$2,000.00

Performance Measurement:

The program resulted in 87% of the student participants scoring at least a 25% increase in performance from the pre-test to the post test. The average increase for all participants who showed an increase was 39%. The pretest used was the Florida Standards Quiz, Unit Standards Assessment number 1 and the post test was the Florida Standards Quiz, Unit Standards Assessment number 2.
