WHEREAS, the Drowning Prevention Coalition of Palm Beach County was created to generate public awareness of the danger of childhood drowning and

WHEREAS, the Drowning Prevention Coalition of Palm Beach County has proposed an Interlocal Agreement with Wellington to provide for vouchers for free swimming lessons for those individuals under the "Buck" Program who may not otherwise have the ability to afford them; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Village Council approve the Interlocal Agreement with the Drowning Prevention Coalition of Palm Beach County; and

WHEREAS, such Interlocal Agreement has been prepared and a copy is attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S **COUNCIL** that:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified as being true and correct.

SECTION 2. The Wellington Council hereby approves the Interlocal Agreement with the Drowning Prevention Coalition of Palm Beach County, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and hereby authorizes the Mayor and Clerk to execute the Agreement.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
