## 1 **RESOLUTION NO. 2018-66** 2 3 A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL 4 APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER OR 5 DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TO PROVIDE 6 7 FOR THE USE OF INMATE LABOR IN WORK PROGRAMS 8 WITHIN THE WELLINGTON ENVIRONMENTAL PRESERVE 9 AT THE MARJORY STONEMAN DOUGLAS EVERGLADES 10 HABITAT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 11 12 13 WHEREAS, Sections 944.10(7) and 946.40 of the Florida Statutes and Rules 33-14 601.201 and 33-601.202 of the Florida Administrative Code authorize the use of inmate 15 labor for various work programs; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Corrections and Wellington have negotiated a contract for the use of inmate labor for the maintenance of the Wellington 18 19 Environmental Preserve at the Marjory Stoneman Douglas Everglades Habitat; and 20 21 WHEREAS, said Contract provides for a term of one (1) year with an additional 22 three (3) one (1) year renewal options; and 23 24 WHEREAS, under the terms of the Contract it is anticipated that the Department 25 of Corrections will be paid \$57,497.00 annually for the guard and work squad; and 26 27 WHEREAS, Council approved entering into the renewal of the previous contract 28 through Amendment #2 and Resolution R2018-63; and 29 30 WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Contract between Wellington and the 31 Florida Department of Corrections be approved for a period of one (1) year expiring on 32 January 6, 2020. 33 34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S 35 **COUNCIL** that: 36 37 **SECTION 1.** The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified as being true 38 and correct. 39 40 SECTION 2. The Wellington Council hereby approves the Contract with the 41 Florida Department of Corrections (attached hereto as Exhibit "A") and authorizes the 42 Manager or his Designee to execute said agreement on behalf of Wellington. 43 44 **SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption. 45
