ADDENDUM NO. ONE

PURPOSE: The purpose of this Addendum/NOTICE is to make changes, additions, deletions, revisions, and clarifications to the (ITB) Invitation to Bid documents for the Binks Pointe Pathway. Bidder shall review the Addendum/NOTICE work and requirements in detail and incorporate any effects the Addendum/NOTICE may have in their proposal price.

1. Question: Can/Will additional vendors be considered for the Pre-Fabricated Bridge?

Response: No, Per the FDOT Plans Preparation Manual, the following applies:

Included in the plan set are Pedestrian Bridge Data Sheets submitted by bridge producers that are eligible to participate in this project. Producers who failed to submit a data sheet are excluded from participation. No Cost Savings Initiative Proposal will be accepted for the truss superstructure portion of the project. Contact information for the eligible producers is included in the data sheet.

2. Question: Do you have a soils report?

Response: Yes, a copy of the soils report has been included with this addendum.

3. Question: Can a contractor otherwise meeting the requirements, but with only with three (3) experience be considered for this project?

Response: Yes, please see revisions to Article 3.1 A and B below:

- A. Contractor shall be a FDOT pre-qualified contractor and shall have a minimum of three (3) consecutive year's experience in the similar projects as described in the plans and bid documents. Key employees shall have worked on FDOT LAP projects.
- B. References from a minimum of three (3) other project owners for comparable projects within the past 5 years.

4. Question: What is the Engineer's estimate?

Response: The estimate is \$715,000.

5. Question: Specification section 01020 Allowances states there is to be an Unforeseen Conditions Allowance of a lump sum of \$100,000 for this project. The bid form has a line item for Unforeseen Condition Allowance but the item does not have the \$100,000 shown on the form. Is there a reason the amount on the form is blank for this item? Do bidders put in any amount they want or are bidders required to include this exact amount on the form?

Response: Please see revised Schedule of Values attached.

6. Clarification: Please note "Others" referenced on Sheet S3.1 is "Contech"

ADDENDUM NO. TWO

PURPOSE: The purpose of this Addendum/NOTICE is to make changes, additions, deletions, revisions, and clarifications to the (ITB) Invitation to Bid documents for the Binks Pointe Pathway. Bidder shall review the Addendum/NOTICE work and requirements in detail and incorporate any effects the Addendum/NOTICE may have in their proposal price.

1. **The bid opening date and time has changed. Bid are due November 7, 2018 at 10:00am.**
2. **Question: Completion of what activities constitutes Substantial Completion. Similarly, completion of what activities constitutes Final Completion.**
Response: Substantial completion is achieved when construction is complete to the point where the pathway can be opened for use and only minor punch list items remain. Final completion is when all punch list items are complete and the Village accepts the project.
3. **Question: What elevations were the two SPT borings taken from?**
Response: Approximately elevation 17-18 NAVD or existing crown of the road elevation.
4. **Question: Please confirm that any Contractor costs or delays encountered as a result of unforeseen utility conflicts will be compensated by the Owner.**
Response: Additional contractor cost and delays will be handled as prescribed by the contract documents.
5. **Question: Please confirm that any Contractor costs or delays encountered as a result of obstructions will be compensated by the Owner**
Response: Additional contractor cost and delays will be handled as prescribed by the contract documents.
6. **Question: As discussed at the Pre-Bid Meeting, please confirm that due to the significant lead time on the pre-fabricated bridge the Owner will issue a delayed or phased NTP. We suggest that the NTP and construction performance period be negotiated and mutually agreed upon and documented in the Contractor's Construction Schedule which would designate the NTP relative to the bridge's delivery date. Please confirm this will be acceptable.**
Response: Agreed, an NTP will be provided in coordination with the availability of the pre-fabricated bridge structure. The selected contractor shall coordinate closely with both the Village of Wellington and Bridge manufacturer to ensure the timely delivery of the structure.

7. Question: Contract Agreement Section 16, Paragraph #3 – What is the maximum dollar amount or percentage of Contract that the Owner can claim for consequential damages? We ask that you please consider removing the consequential damage language from the Contract.

Response: There is no maximum dollar amount or percentage. The language shall remain the same.

8. Question: Please clarify the limits of the staging area.

Response: A staging area will be provided along the west side of Flying Cow Road.

9. Question: What is the voltage of the overhead power lines around the site?

Response: There are multiple types of power lines within the construction area. Voltages of a particular line must be coordinated with Florida Power and Light.

10. Question: Is the Owner aware of any non-811-member utilities in the area?

Response: The village has called 811 locates for design as well as contracted with WGI group to locate utilities within the construction area. All found facilities are shown on the construction plans.

11. Question: Please clarify which (if any) pipes are to be desilted.

Response: No pipes are to be de-silted.

12. Question: Is strength testing of the bridge bolts required?

Response: Bolt certification is required prior to installation.

13. Question: Can a bid form be provided in MS Excel format?

Response: Yes, please see separate attachment for Excel document.

14. Question: Section 02210 indicates that excavated material can be used for backfill. Will testing of this material be required to establish suitability?

Response: The CEI and City will perform a visual test once all unsuitable material has been removed from the excavated material, however standard density tests will apply.

15. Question: Is the contractor required to provide a full QAQC program in accordance with FDOT specifications?

Response: Yes.

16. Question: Is a Class V finish required for the bridge abutments?

Response: Class 5 coating should be placed on all exposed surfaces of the retaining wall.

17. Question: Section 455-5.1 indicates that predrilling is initially only allowed to a depth of 10', but that is not sufficient to get through the extremely hard layer of rock that is depicted in the soil borings. Will predrilling be allowed to a depth sufficient to clear that layer?

Response: Yes.

18. Question: Please provide the top and bottom elevations (in NAVD88) of the limestone layer for Borings B-1 and B-2.

Response: B-1 approximately 13.0 to 4.0 NAVD,
B-2 approximately 10.0 to 6.0 NAVD.

19. Question: Can any of the surrounding overhead power lines be de-energized during construction in order to ensure compliance with OSHA regulations?

Response: Not that we are aware of.

20. Question: Will the Contractor be allowed to pre-auger, predrill, or pre-form holes through the existing hard layer of limestone or to the minimum tips specified on the plans prior to installation of the precast concrete piles and steel sheet piles?

Response: Yes the contractor can pre auger or punch as required to penetrate the hard soil layer.


21. Question: The plans call for AZ 14-700 steel sheet pile. Please confirm that AZ 14-770 is acceptable.

Response: Note the plans should have read AZ 14-770 not AZ 14-700. A revised sheet S3.1 and S3.2

22. Question: Will an equivalent sheet be considered if the material properties are similar?

Response: Equivalent Hot-rolled sections will be considered on a case by case basis.

ADDENDUM NO. THREE

PURPOSE: The purpose of this Addendum/NOTICE is to make changes, additions, deletions, revisions, and clarifications to the (ITB) Invitation to Bid documents for the Binks Pointe Pathway. Bidder shall review the Addendum/NOTICE work and requirements in detail and incorporate any effects the Addendum/NOTICE may have in their proposal price.

1. **Question: Per the Schedule of Values; Bid Item 9, 1" Type SP-12.5 Asphalt Surface Crsr: {you cannot place SP-12.5 @ 1-inch due to the larger stone mix}**

Response: The plans and specifications prescribe SP-9.5 as the asphalt mix. SOV Bid item 9 has been revised to SP-9.5, per the plans and specifications. Line item 9A has been added to the SOV for 50 square yards of 2" Type SP-9.5 Asphalt Surface Course. See revised Schedule of Values attached. It should be noted that the specifications 3.08 called for SP 12.5, however SP 9.5 is to be used on this project per the plans and schedule of values.

2. **Question: It would have to be per the plan sheet C7 that is spec out: 1" and 2" SP-9.5 mix**

Response: Noted, see response to question above.

3. **Question: In the prebid, it was mentioned that the contractor must maintain 2-way traffic at all times, but the plans & specs don't seem to indicate that and we haven't seen that anywhere in the bid package. We assumed it would be addressed in an addendum. That is a major factor in the bid preparation and we need time to estimate one way or the other once it's addressed. Can you clarify whether a single lane closure is allowable?**

Response: A single lane closure will only be allowed during working hours, and when MOT personnel are onsite to direct one-way traffic through the work zone. Two-way traffic and appropriate MOT will be required during non-working hours. The two-way traffic should be provided per FDOT specifications, as detailed in the contract documents, item no. 32 as follows:

Traffic Control and Maintenance. To the extent applicable, the Contract Sum includes all traffic control and traffic control costs related to the Work. The Maintenance of Traffic Plan and all traffic warning and control devices shall conform to the applicable provisions of the latest editions of the national "Manual On Uniform Traffic Control Devices" (MUTCD), and the 600 series of the Florida Department of Transportation's "Roadway and Traffic Design Standards". The MOT Plan shall be prepared by a Florida MOT Certified Technician if FDOT standard details are used. If FDOT standard details are not used, a Professional Engineer licensed in Florida shall prepare the MOT Plan. MOT Plans shall be submitted to appropriate agencies for approval. Costs of compliance with this Paragraph are included as part of the Contract Sum.

4. **Question: Plan Sheet C7: Multi-Use Path Section @ FPL Access: There is no bid item for 2" asphalt. Can this area also be shown on the plan sheets?**

Response: See reply above. The 2" asphalt is noted on the plans between stations 39+38.43 and 39+94.89.

5. **Question: I have a question that I think all bidders will need answered.**

Plan sheet C7: Typical sections 1" min Type SP-9.5 Asphalt (one lift)

2" min Type SP-9.5 Asphalt (2-lifts) (FPL area) where is this located?

Schedule of values: 1" Type SP-12.5 Surface Crse 486/yd2

Response: See response to Question 1.

6. **Question: Is it acceptable to enter "See Attached" and enclose responses on separate sheets on the bid forms. (such as equipment owned or current contracts on hand)?**

Response: Yes

7. **Question: Will a full road closure be allowed just for the time when the bridge is being set (less than 8 hours)?**

Response: No

8. **Question: Will the VOW consider nighttime work for the bridge placement?**

Response: No

9. **Question: Is there any additional information on the impact bollard. There is nothing in the specifications or general notes and the plan view offers very little detail as to material and components. Is this bollard specific to a manufacturer and if so, who?**

Response: See Section 01025 – Measurement and Payment Item 3.14 and plan sheet S3.2. No specific manufacturer is specified.

10. **Question: On sheet C4 there are Solar Powered Roadside Flashing Beacon Assemblies in some locations and Solar Powered RRFB's in other locations. The RRFB's are pretty self-explanatory but there are different options for the Roadside beacon. Do they want a single or double beacon? Yellow or Red beacon (I'm assuming yellow)? Do they want it to flash 24/7 or some other activation device. Also what signage on the RRFB, it mentions a stop sign but has the Pedestrian sign on the picture with it. I'm thinking they are wanting advance warning beacons BEFORE the RRFB's. IF that is what they want, do they want the advance warning beacons to come on when someone pushes the push button for the RRFB.?**

Response: Solar Powered Roadside Flashing Beacon (Reference FDOT Index 11862, page 2 or FDOT Standard Plans 700-120, page 3).


- The post will have a single yellow flashing beacon above the warning sign and a single yellow flashing beacon below the warning sign (for a total of 2 beacons)
- This is an advanced warning sign and will flash 24/7. It will not be actuated by or be otherwise connected with the Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon Assembly.
- There will be two warning signs on the post (W11-2 and W13-1p (35))

Solar Powered Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (Reference FDOT Index 11862, page 5 or FDOT Standard Plans 700-120, page 5).

- The post will have a pair of Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons as shown on the index and as per the FDOT Approved Products List.
- The sign will have a pedestrian push button control and an R10-25 sign facing the pedestrian path.

- There will be two warning signs on the post (W11-2 and W16-7p). Additionally, there will be a separate post with an R1-1 sign on the east side of the road, facing the pedestrian bridge. This was shown to be included on the Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon Assembly, but will require its own post. A revised sheet C4 is included with this response showing the two posts in this location.
