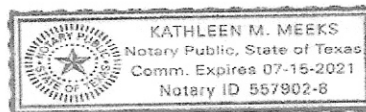

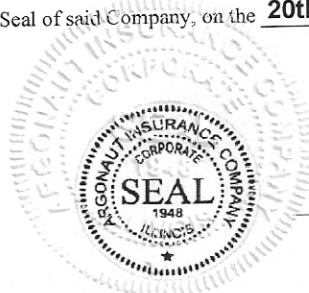

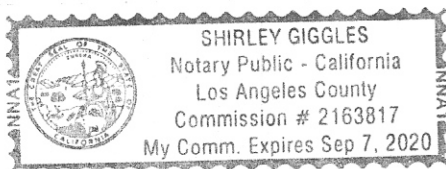

**ADDENDUM NO. ONE**

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this Addendum/NOTICE is to make changes, additions, deletions, revisions, and clarifications to the (ITB) Invitation to Bid documents for the Permanent Watermain Sampling Point Project. Bidder shall review the Addendum/NOTICE work and requirements in detail and incorporate any effects the Addendum/NOTICE may have in their proposal price.

**Notification:** Please note, the deadline for questions is Wednesday, November 21, 2018. The Village offices will be closed at noon for the Thanksgiving Holiday.

1. **Question:** What is the engineers estimate?  
**Response:** The estimate is \$201,000.00.
2. **Question:** What is the construction duration?  
**Response:** Substantial completion is required within 180 days. Final completion is within 210 days.
3. **Question:** Is it intentional that certain sample stations tie in downstream of the backflow and certain ones tie upstream? Are meters required to capture water loss?  
**Response:** Tie-in locations should be per plan. Meters for water loss will not be required.
4. **Question:** Is compaction required for a 1' wide trench?  
**Response:** Shallow pipe trenches (less than 18") shall be compacted by hand tamping.
5. **Question:** Clarify pressure test requirements for sampling assemblies.  
**Response:** New service lines shall be visually inspected under water system pressure for leaks. Any observed leaks will be repaired by the contractor.
6. **Question:** Does the contractor need to take possession of all the sample points purchased by the Village of Wellington at one time?  
**Response:** No. The Village of Wellington can store the proposed sample points and the Contractor can pick-up the material on an as-needed basis. The Village and the Contractor will inspect the materials together. The Village already has 60 of the 70 required sample point assemblies and is ordering the remaining 10.

7. **Question:** The documents state the required "3/4 tap w/double strap 316 SS saddle and Corp Stop".  
**ISSUE:** The standard saddle for Village of Wellington is a bronze saddle with stainless steel straps. The corporation stop is generally brass not stainless steel. A complete stainless steel saddle and corp stop would make the project cost more than 3 times the expense needed to perform the same operation.

**Response:** Saddles shall be per the Village of Wellington Approved Products List.

8. **Question:** The box for the curb stop is listed as 4". The little 3/4 inch curb stop has a turn key with a 1 inch dimension. wouldn't a 2" Box or 3" box be more feasible?

**Response:** The detail has been revised to allow for a 3" box.

9. **Question:** All sidewalks are constructed with compression strength of 3000 psi. Is 4000 Psi concrete for a concrete pad really necessary. Again, the result does not justify the added cost.

**Response:** The detail has been revised to allow for 3000 psi compression strength and 6"x6" welded wire fabric.

10. **Question:** Similarly, the concrete pad depicts #5 at 12 inch on center each way. There is no description on the width of the concrete pad. If you assume it is also 36 inches, there will be a total of 8 bars in a concrete pad which is not subject to loading. At lease the sidewalks get tractors, pedestrians and the occasional parked car. The sidewalks do not contain any steel. Perhaps 6"x6" Welded wire fabric is more suitable for this installation.

**Response:** See response for #9.


11. **Question:** Many of the sample stations conduits at the Lift Station locations appear to be placed under the Lift Station Concrete Slab. Some are along the fence. As you are aware, there is a grounding grid, piping, signal wire, and electrical conduits under most of these slabs. As each location varies, there is an extreme risk in installing the 3/4 inch tubing under these slabs. Wouldn't the location of the sample points be better served by installing the sampling station adjacent to the back flow preventers? Or at least as close as possible so long as the sampling station is in a protected location.

**Response:** Sample points have been located considering layout and function of the station. Contractor should bid general locations shown on the plan and also consider that location of the sample point shown is approximate and that the Owner will stake the exact location in the field prior to construction as noted. Refer to the note found twice on each page of the sampling station location plans.

12. **Question:** Are bollards to be placed around the sample stations? (detail # 7 on detail sheet C5-1 ) If so how many bollards at each location.

**Response:** Bollards are required only specifically where noted on the individual site plans, such as sample point 46, see attached revised plan sheet. Please note, the revised sheet replaces the original C5-1 sheet.

**ACKNOWLEDGEMENT:** Bidder must acknowledge receipt of any and all Addenda in the space provided on the Bidder Submittal Form. Failure to do so may result in rejection of the Proposal. All requirements of the proposal documents remain unchanged except as cited herein.
