SECTION 8. The powers and duties of the Education Committee shall be to advise the Village Council on the following matters:

1. Monitor and develop recommendations regarding actions of the Palm Beach County School Board which may have an impact on Wellington schools, including the Palm Beach County School Board Five Year Plan and Capital Budgets, proposed school sites, and legislation at the local and state level.
2. Gather input from parents, teachers, principals, and students on issues that may have an impact on the children in Wellington schools.
3. Assist with educational scholarships as appropriate.
4. Assist with educational grants as appropriate.
5. Establish relationships with key decision makers at the Palm Beach County School Board to maintain open lines of communication on behalf of Wellington's school children.
6. Develop recommendations to the Council, which may be taken in support of educational facilities and programs for local, state, and federal levels.
7. Coordinate with the other Village Committees or Departments as appropriate.
8. Coordinate with local businesses programs to offer students technical and vocational training within the community.

SECTION 9. The provisions of this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
