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A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA REPEALING RESOLUTIONS R98-57, AND R99-31 AND R2000-42; CREATING AN EDUCATION COMMITTEE: PROVIDING FOR POLICIES. PROCEDURES AND PURPOSE; AND PROVIDING FOR POWERS AND DUTIES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Wellington, Florida has deemed it to be in the best interest and public welfare of the citizens of the Village of Wellington to establish an Education Committee and set forth applicable provisions.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE **VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA that:**

- Resolutions R98-57, and R99-31 and R2000-42 are hereby SECTION 1. repealed.
 - **SECTION 2.** An Education Committee is hereby created.
- **SECTION 3.** The Education Committee shall be composed of seventen (710) members with each Village Council member appointing onetwo (12) board members for a term of two (2) years and at least two (2) alternate (At Large) alternate members appointed by a majority vote of the Council at largeas reflected in Ordinance No. 2010-15. All alternates shall be appointed for one (1) year terms.
- **SECTION 4.** Members of the committee shall be appointed from the residents and electors of the Village of Wellington who are knowledgeable and concerned with educational issues in the community.
- **SECTION 5.** Four (4) Six (6) members in attendance shall constitute a quorum of the committee.
- SECTION 6. Decisions and recommendations of the committee shall be determined by a majority vote. Minutes shall be kept of the proceedings at each meeting and shall record the official acts taken by the committee.
- **SECTION 7.** An organizational meeting of the committee shall be held as soon as practical after the creation thereof by the Village Council. A chairman and vice chairman shall be elected by the committee from its membership for terms of one (1) year. The committee shall adopt reasonable rules of procedure to govern the conduct of its business and the holding of hearings consistent with Florida law. At least one (1) regular meeting of the committee shall be held quarterly, and special meetings may be
