13 14 15 16	WHEREAS , on January 27, 2009, through Resolution R2009-09, Wellington's Council approved an Interlocal Agreement with an original term of five (5) years beginning on May 21, 2009 and including two (2) five (5) year renewals; and
17 18 19 20	WHEREAS, on April 8, 2014, through Resolution R2014-23, Wellington's Council approved a First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement which is scheduled to expire on May 20, 2019; and
21 22 23	WHEREAS, the County and the Village desire to continue the leasing agreement; and
24 25 26	WHEREAS, under this Agreement, as in the original, the County will continue to provide all normal maintenance service and parts at a cost of \$304.00 per month; and
27 28 29 30	WHEREAS, Staff recommends approval of the Second Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement between the Village of Wellington and Palm Beach County extending the Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", five (5) years to May 20, 2024.
31 32 33	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL that:
34 35 36	SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified as being true and correct.
37 38 39 40	SECTION 2. The Wellington Council hereby accepts and approves the Fuel Control Agreement with Palm Beach County attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to execute said Agreement.
