**A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL  
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION  
TO THE PALM BEACH TRANSPORTATION PLANNING  
AGENCY FOR A TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES  
GRANT REQUESTING \$934,101 TO CONSTRUCT  
BICYCLE LANES ON GREENVIEW SHORES BOULEVARD  
FROM WELLINGTON TRACE TO BINKS FOREST DRIVE;  
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Wellington has the opportunity to apply for a grant from the Palm Beach Transportation Agency's Transportation Alternatives grant program for improvements associated with Wellington's approved Bicycle and Pedestrian Circulation Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, Wellington is requesting funding in the amount of \$934,101, understanding the total amount of grant funding could change at the time the project goes under contract; and

**WHEREAS**, Wellington's Village Council authorizes the Village Manager or his designee to direct and execute the necessary documents to comply with this Resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, Wellington is committed to providing funds for the maintenance of the facilities being constructed through its regular maintenance budgeting.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WELLINGTON FLORIDA'S COUNCIL that:**

**SECTION 1.** That the above recitals are hereby adopted.

**SECTION 2.** The Council of the Village of Wellington, Florida, hereby approves and authorizes the Village Manager or his designee to submit an application to Palm Beach Transportation Planning Agency, for a Transportation Alternatives grant, for the funding of improvements identified in Wellington's approved Bicycle and Pedestrian Circulation Plan.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
