## 2 A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL 3 REPEALING RESOLUTIONS R98-57, R99-31 AND R2000-4 42: CREATING AN EDUCATION COMMITTEE: PROVIDING 5 **FOR** POLICIES, **PROCEDURES** AND 6 **PURPOSE**: 7 PROVIDING **FOR POWERS DUTIES:** AND AND 8 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 9 10 WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Wellington, Florida has deemed it to be in the best interest and public welfare of the citizens of the Village of Wellington 11 12 to establish an Education Committee and set forth applicable provisions. 13 14 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE 15 **VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA that:** 16 17 **SECTION 1.** Resolutions R98-57, R99-31 and R2000-42 are hereby repealed. 18 19 **SECTION 2.** An Education Committee is hereby created. 20 21 SECTION 3. The Education Committee shall be composed of seven (7) 22 members with each Village Council member appointing one (1) board member for a 23 term of two (2) years and two (2) At Large members appointed by a majority vote of the 24 Council as reflected in Ordinance No. 2010-15. 25 26 **SECTION 4.** Members of the committee shall be appointed from the residents 27 and electors of the Village of Wellington who are knowledgeable and concerned with 28 educational issues in the community. 29 30 **SECTION 5.** Four (4) members in attendance shall constitute a quorum of the 31 committee. 32 33 SECTION 6. Decisions and recommendations of the committee shall be 34 determined by a majority vote. Minutes shall be kept of the proceedings at each 35 meeting and shall record the official acts taken by the committee. 36 37 **SECTION 7.** An organizational meeting of the committee shall be held as soon as practical after the creation thereof by the Village Council. A chairman and vice 38 39 chairman shall be elected by the committee from its membership for terms of one (1) 40 year. The committee shall adopt reasonable rules of procedure to govern the conduct 41 of its business and the holding of hearings consistent with Florida law. At least one (1) 42 regular meeting of the committee shall be held quarterly, and special meetings may be 43 called by the chairman as appropriate, upon due notice. 44 45 **SECTION 8.** The powers and duties of the Education Committee shall be to advise the Village Council on the following matters: 46
