6	AMENDMENT TO MODIFY ARTICLE 5, IN ITS ENTIRETY, AS				
7	CONTAINED HEREIN; TO ESTABLISH SPECIFIC STANDARDS				
8	RELATED TO THE DEVELOPMENT REVIEW PROCEDURES FOR				
9	DEVELOPMENT APPLICATIONS; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS				
10	CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN				
11	EFFECTIVE DATE.

13	WHEREAS, the Village Council, Florida, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority				
14	vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider				
15	changes to its Land Development Regulations (LDR); and				
16					
17	WHEREAS, upon incorporation in 1996, the Village elected to utilize the Palm Beach County				
18	(PBC) Unified Land Development Code (ULDC), as the LDR for the Village of Wellington; and				
19					
20	WHEREAS, over the years minor amendments to the LDR have been codified to address				
21	changed conditions or to modify the code to suit specific needs of the Village to ensure the health,				
22	safety, welfare and overall quality of life; and				
23					
24	WHEREAS, Wellington believes that it is in the best interest of the community to make				
25	additional modifications to the LDR to streamline the development review process, to establish a				
26	process that best serves the public, and to create an incentive for betterment of future development				
27	and redevelopment;				
28					
29	WHEREAS, on September 26, 2017, the Village Council adopted Ordinance 2017-11 to				
30	repeal and replace, in its entirety, Article 5 of the LDR;				
31					
32	WHEREAS, a Development Review Manual was adopted by Resolution No. R2017-40, in				
33	accordance with section 5.2.2(A) of the LDR;				
34					
35	WHEREAS, additional changes or minor modifications are required to further streamline the				
36	development process;				
37					
38	WHEREAS, The Planning, Zoning and Adjustment Board, acting as the Local Planning				
39	Agency, after notice and public hearing on, has reviewed the proposed Ordinance for				
40	consistency with Wellington's Comprehensive Plan and made a recommendation for approval with				
41	a vote; and

43	WHEREAS, Village Council has taken the recommendations from the Local Planning				
44	Agency, Wellington staff and the comments from the public into consideration as part of the review				
45	of the proposed amendment to the LDR that are the subject of this Ordinance.

47	NOW THERFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA

50	SECTION 1. Article 5, Development Review Procedures of the Wellington Land				
51	Development Regulations, is hereby repealed and replaced, in its entirety, as specifically provided				
52	for in Exhibit A of the Ordinance.
