## **RESOLUTION NO. 2019-48**

A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL **FORMAL** PROGRAM ADOPTING FOR **PUBLIC** INFORMATION. INCLUDING FLOOD **RESPONSE** PREPARATIONS AND FLOOD INSURANCE PROMOTION. FOR INTEGRATION INTO WELLINGTON'S COMMUNITY RATING SYSTEM, TO MEET THE NEW REQUIREMENTS OF FEMA'S COMMUNITY RATING SYSTEM; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS: PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY: AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

- WHEREAS, implementation of formally adopted Programs for Public Information (PPI) and Flood Response Preparation (FRP) practices and procedures is required for optimizing community credit points for public outreach projects and activities performed under the new requirements of FEMA's Community Rating System (CRS) program; and
- **WHEREAS**, Outreach projects conducted under PPI and FRP rules can receive credit multipliers of 40% or more; and
- **WHEREAS**, Wellington currently holds a Class 6 CRS rating from the Insurance Services Office and with this rating, property owners in the Special Flood Hazard Area of Wellington receive an incentive discount of 20% on their flood insurance policies; and
- **WHEREAS**, a key element in community class ratings has changed significantly and adopting the PPI and FRP will provide the best opportunity to optimize outreach credits under the new scoring criteria; and
- **WHEREAS**, adoption of PPI and FRP ensures greater community involvement in all aspects of public outreach and promises a more strategic, coordinated approach to reaching target audiences on important flood preparedness matters; and
- **WHEREAS**, staff recommends that Council accept and approve the PPI and FRP for integration into Wellington's CRS.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL that:
  - **SECTION 1.** The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.
- **SECTION 2.** The Wellington Council hereby adopts the PPI and FRP for integration into Wellington's Community Rating System attached to this resolution as Exhibit A.
- **SECTION 3**. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or other part of this Resolution be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such

decision shall not affect the validity of this Resolution as a whole or any portion or part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

**SECTION 4.** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution conflict with any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of any prior City Ordinance, Resolution, or municipal Code provision, then in that event the provisions of this Resolution shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 5.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
