The Village Council of the Village of Wellington, Florida, hereby 28 29 approves and authorizes the submittal of an application for the Hurricane Irma Rebuild 30 Infrastructure Grant Program with the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity. 31 The Village Council hereby authorizes and directs the Village Manager to execute and 32 file the application. 33 34 **SECTION 3.** The appropriate Village officials are authorized and directed to 35 execute the necessary documents to comply with this Resolution. 36 37 **SECTION 4.** All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and 38 the same are repealed to the extent of such conflict. 39 40 **SECTION 5.** If any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held 41 by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such 42 unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered eliminated and will in no way affect 43 the validity of the other provisions of this Resolution. 44 45 **SECTION 4.** The Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
