ORDINANCE NO. 2019-10 1 2 3 AN ORDINANCE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL 4 MOVING THE DATE FOR THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO 5 BE HELD CONCURRENT WITH THE PRESIDENTIAL 6 PREFERENCE PRIMARY; AMENDING THE CANDIDATE 7 QUALIFYING PERIOD; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE 8 DATE. 9 10 WHEREAS, the Village of Wellington's Charter provides that the regular Village elections are to be held on the second Tuesday in March of each election year and any 11 12 required runoff is to be held on the fourth Tuesday in March; and 13 WHEREAS, the Village of Wellington's Charter further provides that the qualifying 14 period shall be no sooner that noon the last Tuesday in January nor later than noon on 15 16 the second Tuesday in February of the year in which the election is to be held; and 17 18 WHEREAS, the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections has requested that 19 all municipalities move the dates of their municipal election to March 17, 2020 and change 20 their qualifying periods; and 21 22 WHEREAS, Section 101.75 Florida Statutes, provides that the governing body of 23 a municipality may, by ordinance, move the date of a municipal election to a date 24 concurrent with any statewide or countywide election. 25 26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE **VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA:** 27 28 29 **SECTION 1:** The Village of Wellington hereby amends its 2020 Municipal Election 30 schedule as follows: 31 32 a) Wellington Municipal Election will be held on Tuesday, March 17, 2020. 33 b) Runoff election, if required, will be held on Tuesday, March 31, 2020. 34 c) Qualifying periods for candidates will be from noon on Tuesday, December 3, 2019 to 35 noon on Tuesday, December 17, 2019. 36 37 **SECTION 2.** Nothing herein is intended to create a permanent change to the Village Charter. Following the March 17, 2020 election, and any subsequent runoff, 38 39 Wellington's municipal elections shall thereafter comply with its Charter. 40 **SECTION 3.** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this 41 42 Ordinance conflict with any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of any prior Wellington 43 Ordinance, Resolution, or Municipal Code provision; then in that event the provisions of 44 this Ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict. 45 **SECTION 4:** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this

Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision
