17 18	County (PBC) Unified Land Development Code (ULDC), as the LDR for the Village of Wellington; and

20	WHEREAS, over the years minor amendments to the LDR have been codified to address				
21	changed conditions or to modify the code to suit specific needs of the Village to ensure the				
22	health, safety, welfare and overall quality of life; and				
23 24	WHEREAS, Wellington believes that it is in the best interest of the community to make				
24 25	additional modifications to the LDR to streamline the development review process, to establish				
26	a process that best serves the public, and to create an incentive for betterment of future				
27	development and redevelopment; and

29	WHEREAS, The Planning, Zoning and Adjustment Board, acting as the Local Planning				
30 31	Agency, after notice and public hearing on November 13, 2019, has reviewed the proposed Ordinance for consistency with Wellington's Comprehensive Plan and made a recommendation

34	WHEREAS, Village Council has taken the recommendations from the Local Planning				
35	Agency, Wellington staff and the comments from the public into consideration as part of the				
36 37	review of the proposed amendment to the LDR that are the subject of this Ordinance.
