Dear Ms. LaRocque:

Based upon your request and with utmost pleasure, Keshavarz & Associates, Inc. (CONSULTANT) is presenting you with this proposal for construction phase services associated with the above referenced sanitary sewer improvement project. It is our understanding that the VOW will be administering the contract with the chosen CONTRACTOR and shall be acting as the Engineer of Record for the construction phase of the project. The CONSULTANT's role shall be to assist the VOW as needed throughout the construction of the project and shall supplement VOW field personnel as requested. More specifically our scope of services are described as follows:

1. General Consultation Services and Miscellaneous Services:

The CONSULTANT shall provide general consultation services for the VOW throughout the construction of the project from solicitation of bids to the final construction completion of the project. These services include but are not limited to coordination and correspondence with VOW Staff and the CONTRACTOR, attendance of construction progress meetings, interpretation of the construction plans and technical specifications, review of change order requests and other miscellaneous services as needed.

2. Shop Drawing Review / Material Substitutions:

CONSULTANT shall review, evaluate and process shop drawings, CONTRACTOR's selections on the VOW approved materials list, diagrams, illustrations, catalog data, product schedules, samples, results of tests and inspections, and other data which the CONTRACTOR is required to submit to demonstrate that the materials proposed to be used for the work are in substantial compliance with the CONSULTANT's drawings and specifications. All suggested "Substitutions" presented by CONTRACTOR for project's materials and fabrication will also be evaluated throughout the course of the project.

3. Requests For Information:

CONSULTANT shall review and respond to requests for additional information and shall prepare responses and/or construction exhibits as necessary, and coordinate with the VOW to provide directives to the CONTRACTOR in accordance with the contract documents.



4. Construction Observation:

CONSULTANT shall make periodic visits to the site to observe construction at the request of the VOW and shall assist the VOW with Field Services as necessary throughout the construction.

It is understood that CONSULTANT will not, either during such visits or as a result of such observations of CONTRACTOR's work in progress, supervise, direct or have control over CONTRACTOR's work. Nor shall CONSULTANT have authority over or responsibility for the means, methods, techniques, sequences or procedures of construction selected by CONTRACTOR, for safety precautions incident to the work of CONTRACTOR or for any failure of CONTRACTOR to comply with laws, rules, regulations, ordinances, codes or orders applicable to CONTRACTOR furnishing and performing their work. Accordingly, it is understood that CONSULTANT can neither guarantee the performance of the construction contracts by CONTRACTOR nor assume responsibility for CONTRACTOR's failure to furnish and perform their work in accordance with the contract documents.

Services shall be performed on an hourly basis as needed with a not to exceed budget of Sixty-One Thousand Dollars (\$61,000.00).

Attached is the Rate Schedule (Exhibit "B") as agreed upon in our Contract (ITB #011-15/ED) for reference.
