MORE ZONING 5 AMENDMENT TO REPEAL AND REPLACE ARTICLE 3, IN ITS 6 7 ENTIRETY AS CONTAINED HEREIN: TO ESTABLISH SPECIFIC RELATED THE **DEFINITIONS** LAND 8 TO DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE; PROVIDING 9 A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 10 11 WHEREAS, the Village Council, Florida, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority 12 vested in Chapter 163, Chapter 166 and Chapter 177, Florida Statutes, is authorized and 13 empowered to consider changes to its Land Development Regulations (LDR); and 14 15 WHEREAS, upon incorporation in 1996, the Village elected to utilize the Palm Beach 16 County (PBC) Unified Land Development Code (ULDC), as the LDR for the Village of 17 Wellington; and 18 19 WHEREAS, over the years minor amendments to the LDR have been codified to address 20 changed conditions or to modify the code to suit specific needs of the Village to ensure the 21 health, safety, welfare and overall quality of life; and 22 23 24 WHEREAS, Wellington believes that it is in the best interest of the community to make additional modifications to the LDR to streamline the development review process, to establish 25 a process that best serves the public, and to create an incentive for betterment of future 26 27 development and redevelopment; and 28 WHEREAS, The Planning, Zoning and Adjustment Board, acting as the Local Planning 29 30 Agency, after notice and public hearing on _____, has reviewed the proposed Ordinance for consistency with Wellington's Comprehensive Plan and made a recommendation 31 for _____ with a ____ vote; and 32 33 WHEREAS, Village Council has taken the recommendations from the Local Planning 34 Agency, Wellington staff and the comments from the public into consideration as part of the 35 review of the proposed amendment to the LDR that are the subject of this Ordinance. 36 37 NOW THERFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA 38 THAT: 39 40 SECTION 1. Article 3 Definitions of the Wellington Land Development Regulations, is 41 hereby repealed and replaced in its entirety, as specifically provided for in Exhibit A of the 42 43 Ordinance. 44 SECTION 2. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this 45 Ordinance conflict with any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of any prior Wellington 46 Ordinance, Resolution, or Municipal Code provision, then in that event the provisions of this 47 Ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict. 48
