Wellington is required to issue a business tax receipt to the payee of 18 the business tax, but such receipt need not by physically signed by a Village official; and 19 20 WHEREAS, Wellington is converting its internal business processes to a new 21 Enterprise Resource Planning System ("ERP"); and 22 23 WHEREAS, using its ERP system, Wellington will be able to issue business tax 24 receipts electronically, thereby streamlining its processes and improving customer 25 service. 26 27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE 28 **VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA:** 29 30 **SECTION 1:** Chapter 58, Article III, Section 58-69 entitled "Issuance of Receipt" 31 of Wellington's Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows: 32 33 Sec. 58-69. - Issuance of receipt. 34 35 Upon payment of the taxes required by this article, the village shall issue to the person 36 paying the same a receipt signed by an official of the village, which receipt shall expire at the end of the period for which such receipt is issued as specified in this article. 37 38

40 41 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance conflict with any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of any prior Wellington Ordinance, Resolution, or Municipal Code provision; then in that event the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.
