- RE: Ordinance No. 2020-07: Adoption of the Water Supply Facilities 10year Work Plan (Work Plan) and related Comprehensive Plan Amendments

Pursuant to Section 163, Florida Statutes, Wellington is required to prepare a Water Supply Plan within 18 months of the regional water supply plan's approval. The South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) approved the Lower East Coast Water Supply Plan (LECWSP) on November 9, 2018. Wellington's Water Supply Facilities 10year Work Plan (Work Plan) was updated and is attached as Exhibit "A" of Ordinance No. 2020-07. The Work Plan addresses the statutory requirements strengthening the links between the regional water supply plan prepared by the SFWMD and Wellington's water supply plan including the availability of adequate water supplies and public facilities and services to meet projected growth demands, alternative water supplies, and conservation and reuse programs, and a 5-year schedule of capital improvements including each aspect.

The proposed Ordinance adopts the Plan, and incorporates it by reference in the Infrastructure Element of the Comprehensive Plan. In addition, the Land Use, Conservation, Infrastructure, Intergovernmental, Recreation, and Open Space, and Capital Improvements Elements are updated accordingly. The revisions are presented in Ordinance No. 2020-07 as Exhibits "B" through "G", respectively.

The exhibits to Ordinance No. 2020-07 illustrate the proposed text amendments in strikethrough and underline format. Text that is formatted as strike-through is proposed to be deleted and text formatted as underlined is proposed to be added. There are minor revisions to most of the listed elements; however, the majority of the revisions are proposed in the Infrastructure Element as this element is directly impacted by reference to the water supply plan.

The Work Plan is currently included in the Comprehensive Plan as a sub-element to the Infrastructure Element. The proposed ordinance adopts the plan and incorporates it specifically by reference in the Comprehensive Plan.

This Ordinance complies with statutory requirements and the Work Plan is consistent with the Comprehensive Plan. Staff recommends approval of the request as presented.

The Comprehensive Plan Amendment was unanimously approved (7-0) by the Planning, Zoning and Adjustment Board on March 11, 2020.
