15	WHEREAS, Section 163, Florida Statutes, established the Community Planning Act;				
16	and

18	WHEREAS, Section 163, Florida Statutes, requires each municipality in the State of				
19	Florida to prepare and adopt a Comprehensive Plan as required by the Florida Department of				
20	Economic Opportunity; and				
21 22	WHEREAS Council adapted Wallington's Comprehensive Plan on January 10, 1000;				
22 23	WHEREAS, Council adopted Wellington's Comprehensive Plan on January 19, 1999; and

25	WHEREAS, Wellington is required to prepare a 10-year Water Supply Facilities Work				
26	Plan and adopt revisions to the Village's Comprehensive Plan addressing the water supply				
27	requirements within 18 months of the regional water supply plan's approval; and				
28					
29	WHEREAS, the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) approved the				
30 31	Lower East Coast Water Supply Plan (LECWSP) on November 9, 2018; and				
31 32	WHEREAS, Wellington determined it was necessary to update the current Water				
33	Supply Plan and incorporate it within the Infrastructure Element of the Comprehensive Plan.				
34	Additionally, all elements of the Comprehensive Plan were reviewed for references to the				
35	Water Supply Plan for updates; and

37	WHEREAS, the Planning, Zoning and Adjustment Board, sitting as the Local Planning				
38	Agency, after notice and public hearing on March 11, 2020, unanimously recommended				
39 40	approval of the Comprehensive Plan Text Amendment; and				
40 41	WHEREAS, the Council has taken the recommendations from the Planning, Zoning and				
41 42	Adjustment Board, Wellington staff and the comments from the public into consideration when				
42	considering the text amendments to the Comprehensive Plan that are the subject of this				
44	ordinance; and

46	WHEREAS, the Village Council, after notice and public hearing, voted to transmit this				

47 proposed amendment to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity and complied with applicable provisions of the Florida Statutes governing amendments of local Comprehensive 48 49 Plans.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA, THAT: 52

54 **SECTION 1:** The Wellington Water Supply Facilities 10-Year Work Plan (Work Plan), attached as Exhibit "A", is hereby adopted and incorporated by reference in the Infrastructure 55 56 Element of the Comprehensive Plan.

58 SECTION 2: The Future Land Use, Conservation, Infrastructure, Intergovernmental, 59 Recreation and Open Space, and Capital Improvement Elements of the Comprehensive Plan shall be amended as attached in Exhibits "B" through "G". 60

62 **SECTION 3:** The Village Manager is hereby authorized to transmit this Comprehensive Plan Text Amendment to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity for review pursuant 63 to Chapter 163, Florida Statutes. 64

66 SECTION 4: The Village Manager is hereby directed to amend the Comprehensive Plan in accordance with this Ordinance. 67 68

69 **<u>SECTION 5</u>**: Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance conflict with any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of any prior Village 70 Ordinance, Resolution, or municipal Code provision: then in that event the provisions of this 71 Ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict. 72 73

74 **SECTION 6**: Should any section paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall 75 not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any portion or part thereof, other than the 76 part to be declared invalid. 77 78

SECTION 7: The effective date of this Comprehensive Plan Text Amendment shall be 79 31 days after adoption by the Council, if there has not been a compliance challenge with the 80 81 Division of Administrative Hearings. If the ordinance is challenged within 30 days after adoption, the ordinance shall not become effective until the state land planning agency or the 82 Administrative Commission, respectively, issues a final order determining the amendment to 83 84 be in compliance.
