

**CONTRACT BETWEEN
THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS**

AND

THE VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON

This is an Amendment to the Contract between the Florida Department of Corrections (“Department”) and the Village of Wellington (“Agency”), to provide for the use of inmate labor in work programs.

This Amendment:

- Renews the Contract for one (1) year pursuant to Section I., B., Contract Renewal, and revises Section I., A., Contract Term. The Department is exercising its renewal option for one (1) year of the renewal term. A renewal term of one (1) year remains in the Contract; and
- Revises Revised Addendum A, third line.
