ADDENDUM NO. ONE

PURPOSE: The purpose of this Addendum/NOTICE is to make changes, additions, deletions, revisions, and clarifications to the (ITB) Invitation to Bid documents for Annual Asphalt Milling, Resurfacing and Sealcoating Village-Wide. Bidder shall review the Addendum/NOTICE work and requirements in detail and incorporate any effects the Addendum/NOTICE may have in their proposal price.

1. **Question:** In light of COVID -19, will you still hold a public bid opening?
Response: No, the Village of Wellington will hold bid openings via Zoom, in lieu of in person. In addition, we encourage all bidders to submit bids via Wellington's bid portal. The meeting ID and password for this bid opening are as follows- Meeting ID: **919 3594 0685** Password: **450019**.
2. **Question:** May a Mobilization/Demobilization pay item be added to the bid items?
Response: No, all mobilizations shall be included as incidental to and should be included in the unit prices.
3. **Question:** May a bid item (allowance) be added for the bond?
Response: No. Performance and Payment Bonds will be required for each project over \$200,000.00 and shall be included in the unit costs. The bonds shall be furnished prior to issuance of the Purchase Order for the project and shall remain in effect until the project is complete.
4. **Question:** May a pay item be added for Maintenance of Traffic?
Response: Per Section B, #1 of the Specifications: All costs for maintenance of traffic (MOT) shall be considered incidental to, and shall be included in the unit prices for the pay items.
5. **Question:** Please provide an example of a typical work order illustrating items and quantities?
Response: Roadways to be milled and paved will be given out by the Public Works Roads Superintendent or designated Village Representative. The Representative for the Contractor will measure and give the quantities of Milling per Square Yard (SY) and Asphalt Tonnage (TN) with an estimate from the Contract Pricing to the designated Village Representative. The Public Works Department will issue the Purchase Order and schedule the work.
6. **Question:** Please define miscellaneous structures as indicated on Bid Item #9 of the Schedule of Values: Adjust Valve Boxes and Miscellaneous Structures.
Response: Miscellaneous structures include Water/Sewer Valve Risers and Sanitary Sewer/Manhole Riser Rings.
7. **Question:** Can you confirm that bidders can NO BID certain items?
Response: You do not have to bid on all three sections but must bid on all items in the sections you bid on.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT: Bidder must acknowledge receipt of any and all Addenda in the space provided on the Bidder Submittal Form. Failure to do so may result in rejection of the Proposal. All requirements of the proposal documents remain unchanged except as cited herein.
