1 ORDINANCE NO. 2020-18 2 AN ORDINANCE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL 3 AMENDING THE WELLINGTON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, MORE 4 SPECIFICALLY, TO REPEAL THE LAND USE ELEMENT AND 5 6 REPLACE WITH THE LAND USE AND COMMUNITY DESIGN ELEMENT, INCLUDING ANY ELEMENT MAPS, IN ITS ENTIRETY, AS 7 8 CONTAINED HEREIN; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE 9 DATE. 10 11 WHEREAS, the Wellington Council, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority 12 vested in it by Chapter 163, Chapter 166 and Chapter 177, Florida Statutes, is authorized and 13 empowered to consider changes to its Comprehensive Plan (Plan); and 14 15 16 WHEREAS, upon incorporation in 1999, the Wellington Council adopted the first 17 Comprehensive Plan; and 18 19 WHERAS, Chapter 163, Florida Statutes, requires an Evaluation and Appraisal Report (EARs) every seven years to update information and evaluation what changes may be required; 20 and 21 22 WHEREAS, since its initial adoption in 1999 minor amendments to the Comprehensive 23 Plan have been adopted to address changed conditions and/or to suit specific needs of 24 25 Wellington to ensure the health, safety, welfare and overall quality of life; and 26 27 WHEREAS, Wellington believes that it is in the best interest of the community to make update the Comprehensive Plan to identify and set the future direction for the next 10 to 20 28 years; and 29 30 WHEREAS, the proposed amendments to the Comprehensive Plan address updates 31 and new goals, objectives, and policies (GOPs) for all required and optional elements pursuant 32 to Florida Statutes; and 33 34 WHEREAS, each element of the Comprehensive Plan is based upon relevant and 35 appropriate data and analysis, including population projections, studies, plans, and maps, 36 available at the time of adoption of the Comprehensive Plan; and 37 38 WHEREAS, The Planning, Zoning and Adjustment Board, acting as the Local Planning 39 40 Agency, after notice and public hearing on November 17, 2020, has reviewed the proposed Ordinance for consistency with Wellington's Comprehensive Plan and made a recommendation for 41 with a x-x vote: and 42 43 WHEREAS, the Village Council has taken the recommendations from the Local Planning 44 Agency, Wellington staff, and the comments from the public into consideration as part of the review 45
