## ORDINANCE NO. 2020-12 1 2 AN ORDINANCE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL 3 AMENDING THE WELLINGTON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, MORE 4 SPECIFICALLY, TO REPEAL AND REPLACE THE CAPITAL 5 IMPROVEMENTS ELEMENT IN ITS ENTIRETY, AS CONTAINED 6 HEREIN; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A 7 SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 8 9 10 WHEREAS, the Wellington Council, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Chapter 163, Chapter 166 and Chapter 177, Florida Statutes, is authorized and 11 empowered to consider changes to its Comprehensive Plan (Plan); and 12 13 WHEREAS, after incorporation, the Wellington Council adopted the first Comprehensive 14 Plan in 1999; and 15 16 17 WHERAS, Chapter 163, Florida Statutes, requires an Evaluation and Appraisal Report (EARs) every seven years to update information and evaluation what changes may be required; 18 and 19 20 WHEREAS, since its initial adoption in 1999 minor amendments to the Comprehensive 21 Plan have been adopted to address changed conditions and/or to suit specific needs of 22 Wellington to ensure the health, safety, welfare and overall quality of life; and 23 24 WHEREAS, Wellington believes that it is in the best interest of the community to make 25 update the Comprehensive Plan to identify and set the future direction for the next 10 to 20 26 vears: and 27 28 29 WHEREAS, the proposed amendments to the Comprehensive Plan address updates and new goals, objectives, and policies (GOPs) for all required and optional elements pursuant 30 to Florida Statutes; and 31 32 WHEREAS, each element of the Comprehensive Plan is based upon relevant and 33 appropriate data and analysis, including population projections, studies, plans, and maps, 34 35 available at the time of adoption of the Comprehensive Plan; and 36 WHEREAS, The Planning, Zoning and Adjustment Board, acting as the Local Planning 37 Agency, after notice and public hearing on November 17, 2020, has reviewed the proposed 38 Ordinance for consistency with Wellington's Comprehensive Plan and made a recommendation 39 for \_\_\_\_\_ with a \_\_\_ - \_\_ vote; and 40 41 WHEREAS, the Village Council has taken the recommendations from the Local Planning 42 Agency, Wellington staff, and the comments from the public into consideration as part of the 43 review of the proposed amendment to the Comprehensive Plan that are the subject of this 44 Ordinance. 45 46

NOW THERFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA THAT:

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**SECTION 1.** The Capital Improvements Element of the Comprehensive Plan is hereby repealed and replaced, in its entirety as presented in Exhibit A, of the Ordinance.
