28	update the Comprehensive Plan to identify and set the future direction for the next 10 to 20

31	WHEREAS, the proposed amendments to the Comprehensive Plan address updates				
32 33	and new goals, objectives, and policies (GOPs) for all required and optional elements pursuant to Florida Statutes; and

35	WHEREAS, each element of the Comprehensive Plan is based upon relevant and				
36	appropriate data and analysis, including population projections, studies, plans, and maps,				
37	available at the time of adoption of the Comprehensive Plan; and				
38 39	WHEREAS, the Planning, Zoning and Adjustment Board, acting as the Local Planning				
40	Agency, after notice and public hearing on November 17, 2020, has reviewed the proposed				
41	Ordinance for consistency with Wellington's Comprehensive Plan and made a recommendation				
42	for approval with changes with a 5-0 vote; and
