10	WHEREAS the Wellington Council on the governing hedy, purpugat to the outbority
11	WHEREAS, the Wellington Council, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Chapter 163, Chapter 166 and Chapter 177, Florida Statutes, is authorized and
12 13	empowered to consider changes to its Comprehensive Plan (Plan); and
13 14	empowered to consider changes to its comprehensive rhan (rhan), and
15	WHEREAS, after incorporation in 1996, the Wellington Council adopted the first
16	Comprehensive Plan in 1999; and
17	
18	WHERAS, Chapter 163, Florida Statutes, requires an Evaluation and Appraisal Report
19	(EARs) every seven years to update information and evaluation what changes may be required;
20	and
21	
22	WHEREAS, since its initial adoption in 1999 minor amendments to the Comprehensive
23	Plan have been adopted to address changed conditions and/or to suit specific needs of
24	Wellington to ensure the health, safety, welfare and overall quality of life; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, Wellington believes that it is in the best interest of the community to make
27	update the Comprehensive Plan to identify and set the future direction for the next 10 to 20
28	years; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, the proposed amendments to the Comprehensive Plan address updates
31	and new goals, objectives, and policies (GOPs) for all required and optional elements pursuant
32	to Florida Statutes; and
33 34	WHEREAS, each element of the Comprehensive Plan is based upon relevant and
35 35	appropriate data and analysis, including population projections, studies, plans, and maps,
36	available at the time of adoption of the Comprehensive Plan; and
37	available at the time of adoption of the comprehensive rian, and
38	WHEREAS, the Planning, Zoning and Adjustment Board, acting as the Local Planning
39	Agency, after notice and public hearing on March 10, 2021, has reviewed the proposed
40	Ordinance for consistency with Wellington's Comprehensive Plan and made a recommendation
41	for with a x-x vote; and

43	WHEREAS, the Village Council has taken the recommendations from the Local Planning
44	Agency, Wellington staff, and the comments from the public into consideration as part of the
45	review of the proposed amendment to the Comprehensive Plan that are the subject of this
46	Ordinance.
