The original Bid conditions and specifications together with bidder's response **CANNOT** be changed or altered in any way after submitted. Bid must contain a manual signature of authorized representative in the space provided above. Bid must be typed or printed in ink. Use of erasable ink is not permitted.
- 3 PRICES QUOTED AND CASH DISCOUNTS:** Bids must include deductions for trade discounts. Firm net prices must be quoted and both unit price and extended totals must be provided. When requested, prices must be stated in the units of quantity specified in the Bid specifications. In case of discrepancy in computing the amount of the Bid, the **UNIT PRICE** quoted will govern. 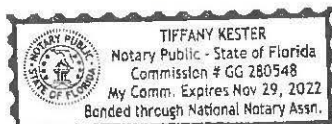



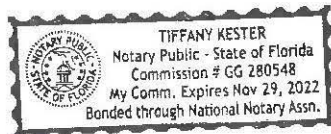
