R2021-37** 2 3 A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL 4 APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND 5 CLERK TO EXECUTE THE LAW **ENFORCEMENT** SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE PALM BEACH 6 7 COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT 8 SERVICES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022; AND PROVIDING AN 9 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** 10 11 12 WHEREAS, since Incorporation, Wellington has contracted with the Palm Beach 13 County Sheriff's Office to provide law enforcement services for the Village of Wellington: 14 and 15 WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement Services Agreement for FY 2021 (Agreement) is effective October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021 and is scheduled to expire at 16 17 the end of the fiscal year; and 18 19 WHEREAS, Article 5.2 of the Agreement provides that the total amount due for 20 all law enforcement services for subsequent years shall be based upon the proposed 21 costs submitted by the Sheriff during Wellington's budget process and approved by 22 Wellington's Council; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the total amount of compensation for the Fiscal Year 2021/2022 is 25 \$10,157,217.00, which reflects a 2% increase over the adjusted FY 2021 contract in the 26 amount of \$10,084,864.00; and 27 28 WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Village Council approve the proposed 29 Law Enforcement Services Agreement between the Village of Wellington and the Palm 30 Beach County Sheriff's Office. 31 32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S 33 **COUNCIL** that: 34 35 **SECTION 1.** The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified as being true 36 and correct. 37 38 **SECTION 2.** The Wellington Council hereby approves the Law Enforcement 39 Services Agreement by and between the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office and the 40 Village of Wellington, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and hereby authorizes the Mayor 41 and Clerk to execute the Agreement. 42 **SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption. 43 44
