Background

As a part of the 2021 Florida Legislative session, House Bill (HB) 59 was approved by the Governor. HB 59 requires local governments to include a property rights element in their comprehensive plans. The property rights element must be adopted by the earlier of the adoption of the next plan amendment initiated or the next evaluation and appraisal report.

Statutory Compliance

The proposed element complies with 163.3167, Florida Statutes requiring the adoption of a property rights element.
