KNOWN AS LAKE WORTH DRAINAGE DISTRICT 25-FOOT 7 WIDE RIGHT-OF-WAY, LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF STATE 8 ROAD 7, APPROXIMATELY A HALF MILE NORTH OF THE FOREST 9 HILL BOULEVARD AND STATE ROAD 7 INTERSECTION, IN PALM 10 BEACH COUNTY, AS MORE SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED HEREIN; 11 DECLARING THAT THE VOLUNTARY ANNEXATION PETITION BEARS THE SIGNATURE OF THE PROPERTY OWNER: AMENDING 12 13 SECTION 11 OF THE VILLAGE CHARTER BY REDEFINING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON; 14 15 DIRECTING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO DO ALL THINGS **NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS ANNEXATION: DIRECTING THE** 16 17 VILLAGE CLERK TO FILE A COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE WITH THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT IN PALM BEACH COUNTY, THE 18 19 CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF STATE WITHIN SEVEN DAYS 20 AFTER ADOPTION, IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 171 OF THE 21 22 FLORIDA STATUTES: PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE: 23 PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 24 25

WHEREAS, Wellington, Florida's Council, has received a written petition from the owner, Lake Worth Drainage District (LWDD) of real property, hereinafter described, who desires that said real property be annexed into Wellington, Florida, pursuant to the provisions of Section 171.044, Florida Statues; and

31 **WHEREAS,** the subject property is a 0.35-acre portion of the 25-foot wide right-of-way 32 (L-7W Canal) owned by the LWDD. As the area to be annexed does not have any registered 33 electors, a vote of electors of the area proposed to be annexed is not required; and

WHEREAS, the subject real property is currently in unincorporated Palm Beach County
 with a Zoning designation of Agricultural Residential and Future Land Use Map designation
 of Low Residential (LR-2); and

WHEREAS, the subject real property is in the future annexation area of Wellington, is contiguous land to the municipal limits, is not irregular in shape and annexation will not result in the creation of an enclave; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of Wellington's Council that it is in the best public interests
 that the real property, described herein, be annexed into the Wellington boundaries.

- SECTION 1: The real property consisting of 0.35-acre, more or less, legally described as set forth in Exhibit A and located in unincorporated Palm Beach County; as indicated on the Location Map in Exhibit B; and being the subject of the aforesaid petition for voluntary annexation, filed pursuant to Section 171.044, Florida Statues, is hereby annexed into the Village of Wellington, Florida.
- 7 **SECTION 2:** Section 12 of the Village Charter, entitled "Land Description," is hereby 8 amended to reflect the property annexed into Wellington by this Ordinance.
- 10 <u>SECTION 3:</u> The Manager is hereby directed to do all things necessary to effectuate
 this annexation.

- 13 <u>SECTION 4:</u> The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file a copy of this Ordinance with 14 the Clerk of the Circuit Court, Palm Beach County, the Chief Administrative Officer of Palm 15 Beach County, and the Department of State within seven (7) days of the adoption of this 16 Ordinance.
- SECTION 5: Should any section paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any portion or part thereof, other than the part to be declared invalid.
- <u>SECTION 6</u>: Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this
 Ordinance conflict with any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of any prior Wellington
 Ordinance, Resolution, or Municipal Code provision; then in that event the provisions of this
 Ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.
- 28 <u>SECTION 7:</u> This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption of the
 29 Council following second reading.
