## ORDINANCE NO. 2021-18 1 2 3 AN ORDINANCE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL AMENDING THE WELLINGTON LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS, MORE 4 SPECIFICALLY, A ZONING TEXT AMENDMENT TO MODIFY SECTION 5 6.4.1.A.5 OF ARTICLE 6, FOR PURPOSES OF MAINTAINING A 6 7 CONSISTENT APPEARANCE FOR HEDGES AND FENCES ALONG THOROUGHFARES, AS CONTAINED HEREIN: PROVIDING A 8 CONFLICTS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; 9 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 10 11 WHEREAS, the Wellington Council, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested 12 in Chapter 163, Chapter 166 and Chapter 177, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to 13 consider changes to its Land Development Regulations (LDR); and 14 15 16 WHEREAS, on January 13, 2020, Wellington's Council adopted the new LDR in its entirety; 17 and 18 19 WHEREAS, maintaining a consistent appearance of privately owned hedges and fences 20 along thoroughfares has been a continuous challenge for the community for decades; and 21 WHEREAS, improving consistency and creating uniformity along Wellington's thoroughfares 22 and throughout the Village is vital to ensure the health, safety, welfare and overall quality of life for 23 Wellington; and 24 25 WHEREAS, as part of visioning process and research, staff has analyzed ways to achieve 26 a neat and orderly appearance of the fences, walls, and hedges Village-wide; and 27 28 29 WHEREAS, a Pilot Program was implemented on a temporary basis to help assist and achieve consistency among property owners; and 30 31 32 WHEREAS, the proposed text amendment to section 6.4.1.A.5 of the Land Development 33 Regulations is consistent with the LDR and Wellington's Comprehensive Plan; and 34 35 WHERAS, the Architectural Review Board, after notice and public hearing on August 18, 2021, has reviewed the proposed ordinance and made a recommendation for approval with a 36 37 unanimous vote (5-0). 38 WHEREAS, the Planning, Zoning and Adjustment Board, acting as the Local Planning 39 Agency, after notice and public hearing on September 8, 2021, has reviewed the proposed 40 ordinance and made a recommendation for with a vote; and 41 42 WHEREAS, the Wellington Council has taken the recommendations from the Local Planning 43 Agency, Wellington staff, and comments from the public into consideration as part of the review of 44 the proposed amendment to Article 6.4.1.A.5 of the Land Development Regulations that are the 45 subject of this ordinance. 46 47 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA 48

**SECTION 1.** Section 6.4.1.A.5 of the Wellington Land Development Regulations, is hereby amended, as specifically provided for in Exhibit A.

**SECTION 3.** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phase of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any portion of part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption of the Wellington Council following second reading.
