PROCLAMATION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL DECLARING NOVEMBER 20th AS TRANSGENDER DAY OF REMEMBRANCE IN THE VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, Transgender Day of Remembrance (TDOR) is an annual observance founded in 1999 that honors the memory of transgender people around the world whose lives have been lost to anti-transgender violence; and

WHEREAS, the annual observance recognized on November 20th, provides a forum for transgender communities and allies to raise awareness of the threat of violence faced by transgender, non-binary and gender non-conforming people and the persistence of anti-transgender prejudice that permeates our society; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Wellington recognizes that transgender members of our communities are disproportionately affected by hate crimes and violence and experience a myriad of challenges in their daily lives due to discrimination, high levels of unemployment and limited access to health care; and

WHEREAS, by observing Transgender Day of Remembrance, the Village of Wellington recognizes, admires and celebrates transgender, gender non-conforming and non-binary members of our community; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Wellington also honors and commemorates the strength, commitment and immense efforts of those working for equity and justice for transgender, gender non-conforming and non-binary people; and

NOW, THEREFORE, Wellington, Florida's Council hereby declares November 20th as Transgender Day of Remembrance in Wellington.
