ORDINANCE NO. 2022-31 PANTHER RUN SCHOOL SITE ANNEXATION

AN ORDINANCE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL; ANNEXING, PURSUANT TO A PETITION FOR VOLUNTARY ANNEXATION, REAL PROPERTY COMPRISING 20 ACRES

LOCATED ON THE NORTH SIDE OF LAKE WORTH ROAD, APPROXIMATELY 0.66 MILE WEST OF STATE ROAD 7 IN PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, KNOWN AS PANTHERS RUN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL; AS MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREIN; DECLARING THAT THE VOLUNTARY ANNEXATION PETITION BEARS THE SIGNATURE OF THE PROPERTY OWNER; AMENDING SECTION 11 OF THE VILLAGE CHARTER BY REDEFINING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF WELLINGTON; DIRECTING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO AFFECTUATE THIS ANNEXATION; DIRECTING THE WELLINGTON CLERK TO FILE A COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE WITH THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT IN PALM BEACH COUNTY, THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF STATE WITHIN SEVEN DAYS AFTER ADOPTION, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 171.044, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Ms. Cramer explained there are three applications for the school site, which if the applicant approves will have one presentation. Ms. Garrison agreed to one presentation. Robert Basehart, Sustainability and Regulatory Affairs Director, presented to the Board one presentation for the Annexation, Comprehensive Plan and Rezoning.

A motion was made by John Bowers, seconded by Ron Herman, to open public comment. The motion passed unanimously (4-0) with Maureen Martinez Tracy Ciucci and Adam Rabin absent.

Howard Gross, 10845 Northgreen Drive, wondered why is Wellington annexing the land now and what can be built there in the future. Mr. Basehart explained there is no intent to develop the land into anything but a school use. Mr. Bowers stated since the school receives the Kelly Spinelli Grant from Wellington, it should be located in Wellington.

A motion was made by John Bowers, seconded by Dr. Satish Raj, to close public comment. The motion passed unanimously (4-0) with Maureen Martinez Tracy Ciucci and Adam Rabin absent.

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

AN ORDINANCE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL AMENDING THE FUTURE LAND USE MAP OF THE WELLINGTON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN BY ADDING AND DESIGNATING 20 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, KNOWN AS THE PANTHER RUN

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, AS "COMMUNITY FACILITIES"; LOCATED ON THE NORTH SIDE OF LAKE WORTH ROAD, APPROXIMATELY 0.66 MILE WEST OF STATE ROAD 7, AS MORE SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED HEREIN; AUTHORIZING THE TRANSMITTAL OF THE AMENDMENT TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
