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### ITEM: AUTHORIZATION TO CONTINUE UTILIZING A U.S. COMMUNITIES CONTRACT, AS A BASIS FOR PRICING, FOR THE PURCHASE AND DELIVERY OF REFUSE CARTS

**REQUEST:** Authorization to continue utilizing a U.S. Communities contract with Rehrig Pacific Company, as a basis for pricing, for the purchase and delivery of refuse carts, in the amount of approximately \$50,000 annually.

**EXPLANATION:** The Public Works Department purchases wheeled trash containers for residential solid waste needs. The Village currently uses Rehrig Pacific Company to provide these containers.

Miami-Dade County, acting as the lead agency for the U.S. Communities, awarded contract #00254 to Rehrig Pacific Company for the purchase and delivery of refuse carts. The Miami-Dade contract is effective through September 30, 2021 with the option to renew for a period of five (5) additional years.

The Miami-Dade County contract provides the best overall value to the Village at \$51.00 per cart. The contract allows for quarterly price adjustments.

Staff requests authorization to utilize a U.S. Communities contract #00254, as a basis for pricing with Rehrig Pacific Company for the purchase and delivery of refuse carts, in the amount of approximately \$50,000 annually.
