**EXPLANATION:** The Statewide Mutual Aid Agreement (attached) has been updated for 2018. The attached Agreement provides for use for smaller events and does not require activation of a state of emergency. The new Agreement replaces the previous Statewide Mutual Aid Agreement approved by Council through Resolution No. R2000-141 on January 9, 2001.
