A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA’S COUNCIL APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE FY 2024/2025 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO FORWARD THE FY 2024/2025 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

B. RESOLUTION NO. R2024-33 (ANALYSIS OF IMPEDIMENTS TO FAIR HOUSING CHOICE)

A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA’S COUNCIL APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE ANALYSIS OF IMPEDIMENTS TO FAIR HOUSING CHOICE; AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO FORWARD THE ANALYSIS OF IMPEDIMENTS TO FAIR HOUSING CHOICE TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

REQUEST: Approval of Resolution No. R2024-32 approving and adopting a FY 2024/2025 Annual Action Plan for the Community Development Block Grant Program, and approval of Resolution No. R2024-33 approving and adopting the Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice.

EXPLANATION: The United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has determined that Wellington qualifies as an “entitlement community” and is eligible to receive funds under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. As such, Wellington is required to submit an Annual Action Plan to receive its annual allocation of CDBG funds.

The Village of Wellington will receive an FY 2024-2025 CDBG allocation of \$289,226. Consistent with Wellington’s proposed FY 2024/2025 budget, the CDBG funds are budgeted as follows:

Housing Rehabilitation Program	\$188,381
Public Services	\$43,000
Planning & Admin	\$57,845
Total FY 2024/2025 CDBG Entitlement Allocation	\$289,226

The Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice (AI) is a requirement that the Village of Wellington must complete to continue receiving Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The AI is an analysis undertaken according to 24 CFR 5.152, to affirmatively further fair housing.
