ITEM: RESOLUTION NO. R2017-36 (FLORIDA POWER AND LIGHT RIGHT-OF-WAY CONSENT AGREEMENT)

A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE RIGHT-OF-WAY CONSENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN WELLINGTON AND FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY (FP&L) REGARDING THE USE OF EASEMENTS LANDS FOR BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN PURPOSES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

REQUEST: Authorization to execute the right-of-way consent agreement between Wellington and Florida Power & Light Company.

EXPLANATION: Wellington received a Transportation Alternatives Program grant from the Palm Beach County Metropolitan Planning Organization in 2015 (FM# 438306-1). This grant provides funding for an eight-foot wide multi-purpose path to connect Bink's Forest Drive to Flying Cow Ranch Road. This path lies within an FP&L easement, and therefore requires a consent agreement between FP&L and Wellington to allow use within the easement. Resolution No. R2017-36 will authorize the mayor to execute this agreement.
